

Webmail

Any domain hosted by our servers can access the webmail feature, as well as pop mail to an external program like Outlook, Eudora, or Thunderbird. Since we have a new server, the webmail has been upgraded as well. The new features include faster indexing of messages, the ability to change the account password, and a few other things.

We encourage you to take a look at your mail at the same address as before:

From there, you can login with your full email and the same password as before.

Change the Account Password

In the past, we set the email account passwords and maintained updates to them. Now we set the initial password and each email account can be changed through the webmail client. To do this, log into the webmail account, select Options from the upper navigation bar, and then choose Change Password from the available options.

- Personal Information:** This contains personal information about yourself such as your name, your email address, etc.
- Message Highlighting:** Based upon given criteria, incoming messages can have different background colors in the message list. This helps to easily distinguish who the messages are from, especially for mailing lists.
- Index Order:** The order of the message index can be rearranged and changed to contain the headers in any order you want.
- POP3 Fetch Mail:** This configures settings for downloading email from a POP3 mailbox to your account on this server.
- Message Filters:** Filtering enables messages with different criteria to be automatically filtered into different folders for easier organization.
- Translation Options:** Which translator should be used when you get messages in a different language?
- TWC Weather:** Setup the weather displaying options. You can add all the cities you want to monitor as well as various options to display.
- New-Mail Options:** This configures settings for playing sounds and/or showing popup windows when new mail arrives.
- Display Preferences:** You can change the way that SquirrelMail looks and displays information to you, such as the colors, the language, and other settings.
- Folder Preferences:** These settings change the way your folders are displayed and manipulated.
- Change Password:** This connects to your local Password Server to change your login password for all services.
- SpamCop - Spam Reporting:** Help fight the battle against unsolicited email. SpamCop reads the spam email and determines the correct addresses to send complaints to. Quite fast, really smart, and easy to use.
- SPAM Filters:** SPAM filters allow you to select from various DNS based blacklists to detect junk mail in your INBOX and move it to another folder (like Trash).
- IMAP server information:** Run some test IMAP commands, displaying both the command and the result. These tests use the SquirrelMail IMAP commands and your current SquirrelMail configuration. Custom command strings can be used.
- SpellChecker Options:** Here you may set up how your personal dictionary is stored, edit it, or choose which languages should be available to you when spell-checking.

To change the password, you only need to enter the old password once. Be sure you have that on hand. Other features of the new server will be explained in subsequent emails.
